Candidates are required to report at 10.00 AM on 30.07.2010 in the Meeting Hall in IMMT's main building for admission to PGDME program with all of their original academic mark sheet and certificates. The selected non sponsored candidates awaiting final results will be provisionally admitted to the programme. Their continuation in the programme will be subjected to securing required percentage/ equivalent grade (depending on the cut off marks for screening) and submission of marks-sheet of their final result by October 30, 2010.

You will have to deposit the following fees at the time of admission:

Non sponsored Candidate

1. Course Fee (1st Instalment) : Rs.20,000/-
2. Library Caution Money (Refundable) : Rs.3,000/-
3. Hostel Caution Money (Refundable) : Rs.4,000/-
4. Hostel Room Rent (for 1st Semester) : Rs.3,900/-

Sponsored Candidate

1. Course Fee (Single Instalment)	: Rs.60,000/-
2. Library Caution Money (Refundable)	: Rs.3,000/-
3. Hostel Caution Money (Refundable)	: Rs.4,000/-
4. Hostel Room Rent (for 1st Semester)	: Rs.3,900/-

Total amount will have to be paid in form of a crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of “PG Diploma in Mineral Engineering” payable at Bhubaneswar. No cash or cheque payment will be accepted.

It may be noted that a student will have to spend around Rs.2000/- extra per month towards food expenses. The students can take their breakfast and lunch in the Institute’s Canteen on working days; they can avail the facility of a restaurant running in the IMMT campus for dinner and food on other days.

As the classes will start from 02.08.2010 (Monday), the students will be provided hostel accommodation on the day of admission. Students, desirous of availing hostel accommodation should note that each student will be provided one cot, one chair, one table and one steel almirah.

Each student will have to give undertaking at the time of admission for good conduct inside the Institute, in hostel and in campus.
