Candidates are required to report at 9.30 AM on 29.07.2011 (Friday) in the Meeting Hall of IMMT's main building for admission to PGDME program with all of their original academic mark sheet and certificates. A set of Xerox copies of documents and one pass port photo (if two photos have not been provided with the application) are required to be submitted at the time of admission. The selected non sponsored candidates awaiting final results will be provisionally admitted to the programme. Their continuation in the programme will be subjected to securing required percentage/ equivalent grade (depending on the cut off marks for screening) and submission of marks-sheet of their final result by October 31, 2011).

You will have to deposit the following fees at the time of admission:

Total amount will have to be paid in form of a crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of **“PG Diploma in Mineral Engineering”** payable at Bhubaneswar. No cash or cheque payment will be accepted.

It may be noted that a student will have to spend around Rs.2500/- extra per month towards food expenses. The students can take their food in the Institute's Canteen.

As the classes will start from 01.08.2011 (Monday), the students will be provided hostel accommodation on the day of admission. Students, desirous of availing hostel accommodation should note that each student will be provided one cot, one chair, one table and one steel almirah.

Each student will have to give undertaking at the time of admission for good conduct inside the Institute, in hostel and in campus.
